

Behaviour Agreement during COVID re-opening school phase



Hester's Way Primary School has been asked by The Department for Education (DFE) to allow key groups of children back into school as part of a phased approach to the re-opening of schools.

To enable this to happen safely and effectively, our home to school agreement has been updated. Please ensure that you share this with your child and everyone follows expectations. This document has been agreed by the Governing Board.

As your child: **xxxxx** has previously shown challenging behaviour in school, we want to ensure that this does not happen on return to school.

Any challenging behaviour, children not following teacher's instructions or completing work, will mean a zero tolerance and immediate request for parents/carers to collect the pupil from school.

If you are not available to collect your child, you must ensure that you ask another person who you deem fit to care for your child to collect them from school.

As we have limited staff and children are learning in "Bubble" groups we have limited areas to wait in school. If your child is not collected with 30 minutes then we may have to seek advice from social care or seek advice from PCSOs.

As we are still very much in a COVID19 Pandemic situation, as a Nation, it is extremely important that the Health, Safety and Well-being of all pupils and staff are considered. Any non-compliance can put everybody at greater risk.

If needed we may follow the GCC Exclusion Guidance.

Please sign this document and return to head@hestersway.glouc.sch.uk before your child starts school or email to say that you agree with the Home School agreement and the Behaviour Agreement.

We very much hope that your child will return to school positively and that these measures will not be necessary, however this is part of our school risk assessment.

- Listen and follow all instructions from adults
- Complete their work when asked – there will not be any 1:1 support due to social distancing
- Have a positive, learning mind-set
