Coronavirus Guidance

The Government say if your children can stay at home , safely, then they should to prevent the spread of this virus.

Whilst, frontline key workers including ourselves continue to work, please can we ask that during this time of challenge and risk to all, that you follow these essential routines in order to protect your child and family, as well as us and our families:

1. Wear clean clothes everyday.
2. When your child gets home wash their clothes, bathe or shower them and put clean clothes on (Everyone in the home should do this when leaving/entering!).
3. Wash hands on entry to home/school, as well as after the toilet, before and after eating, after playtime and before leaving home/school.
4. Sneeze, blow noses and cough into tissues bin or flush down the toilet then wash hands.
5. Treat any colds or sore throats immediately to prevent escalation of symptoms.
6. Keep hydrated with drinks, especially hotter drinks when safe and possible.
7. Eat fruit and veg where possible.

Children can wear their own clothes but these must be clean on every day.

Forest School sessions on Thursday pm and Friday all day—please bring spare, clean clothes for outdoor play.

We will provide bottled water, breakfast, snack and lunch.

We will be providing a variety of activities during the time that your child is with us. These will include: play-based activities, reading, writing, maths, art, sports or physical movement and much more.

We will explain to the children that the Public Health guidance about personal hygiene remains and that children should be social distancing as much as possible, as well as adults.

Children will be home or to the second contact on the emergency records if they show any symptoms of Covid-19 symptoms. Similarly, if you have any symptoms we MUST know immediately, in-order to safeguard our staff and their families.
