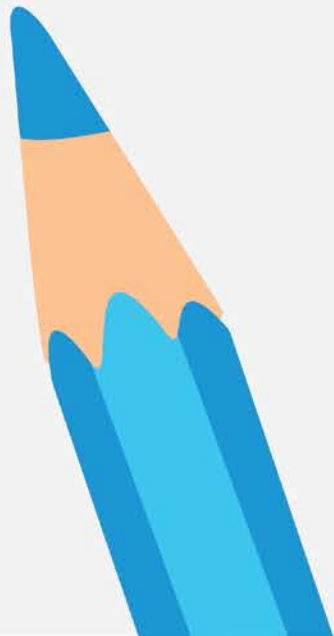
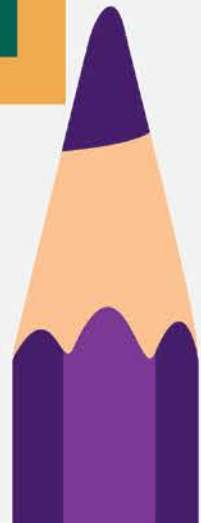
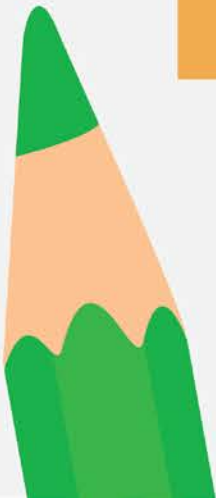




WELCOME TO YEAR 5

LEARNING READING IN YEAR 5

LEARNING MATHS IN YEAR 5

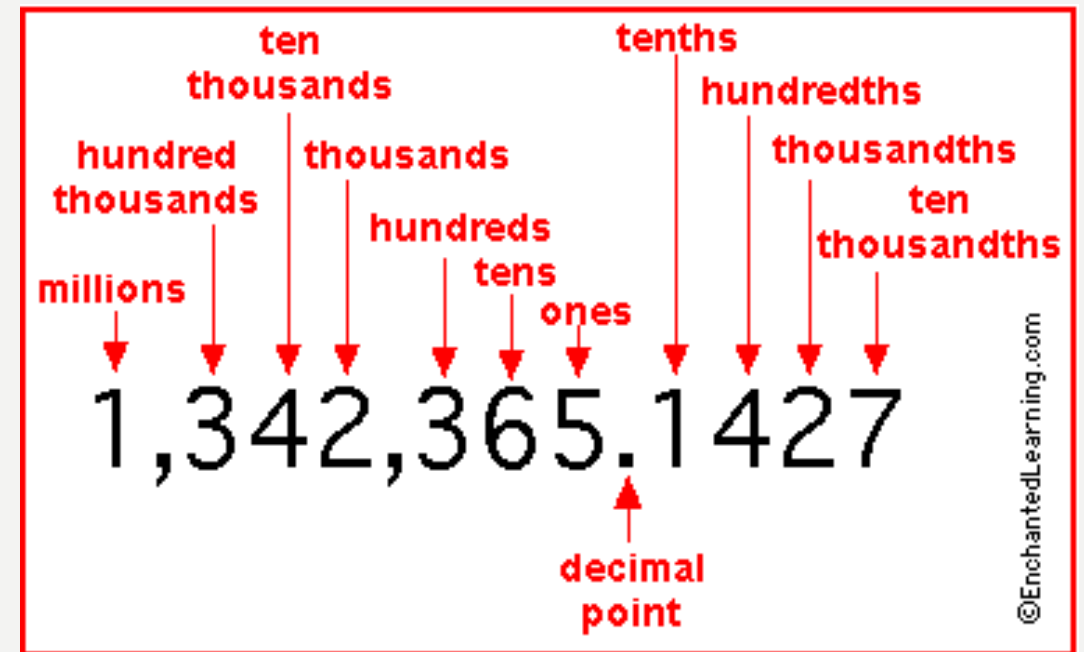
At the beginning of Year 5, we will be start by learning about the place value of 5, 6 and 7 digit numbers. We will be representing them in words and numerals, rounding them, ordering and comparing them and using powers of 10 to count forwards and backwards. To make things even more challenging, we will also be introducing decimals to these numbers.

Later in the year, we will look at other areas such as percentages, fractions, geometry and statistics, as well as many others.

percentage	fraction	decimal
30%	$\frac{3}{10}$	0.3

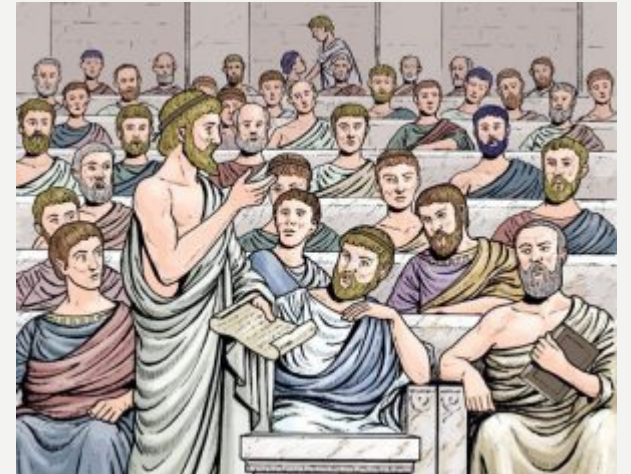
to go from a fraction to a percentage we can **convert to a decimal** first

$\frac{3}{5} \rightarrow 0.6 \rightarrow 60\%$



LEARNING TOPIC IN YEAR 5

In Year 5 we do lots of interesting topics. In the autumn term we learn about how the ancient Greeks introduced democracy to the Europe. We find out a bit about what Greece was like in those times, what their democracy looked like and how it has changed modern day Britain.



UNIFORM
