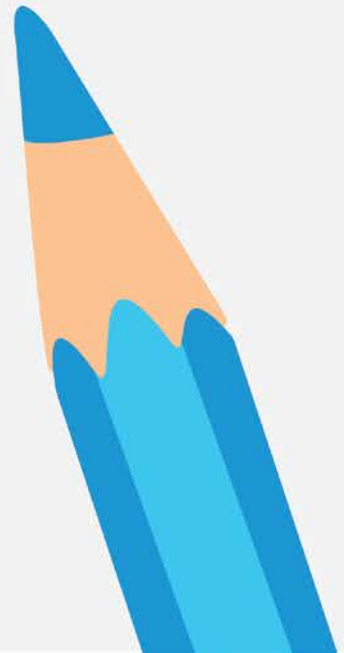
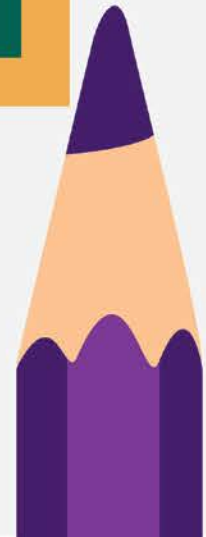
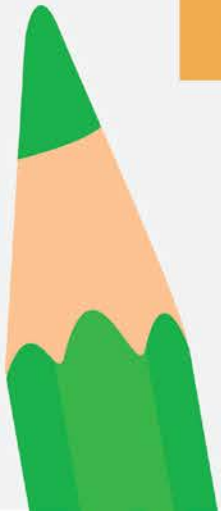




WELCOME TO YEAR 1

We learn Talk for Writing in Year 1 – just like in Reception.

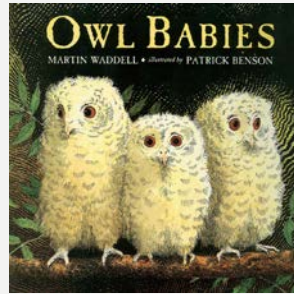
We will learn the story with actions and make a story map, before innovating the story with our own ideas.

We still learn lots of Phonics in Year 1. We use the same scheme for Phonics throughout Reception and Key Stage 1, so we will continue from where the children got to in Reception. We will aim to reach National Standards.

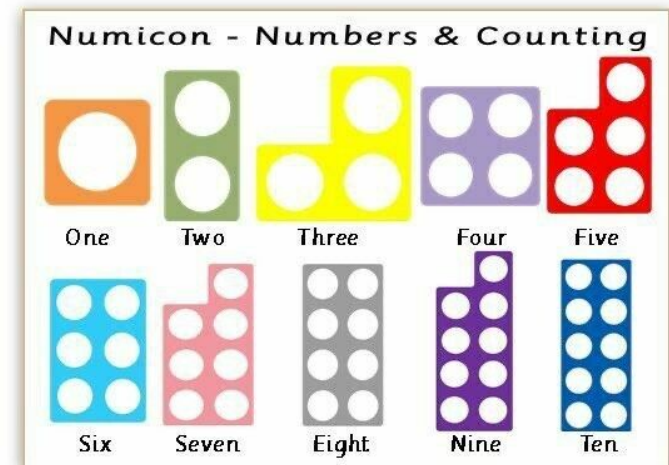
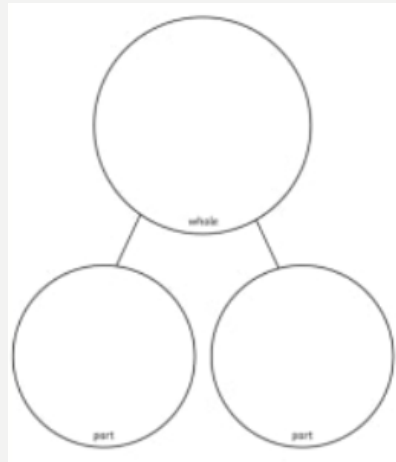

We give out spellings every Thursday ready for a test in class the following Thursday. These are spellings from our phonics lessons and from the Year 1 Common Exception Words lists.

LEARNING IN YEAR 1

In Year 1 we begin by becoming very confident with numbers to 20. We do this in lots of different ways, such as the part whole model, number lines and Numicon resources. Some of these resources will be familiar to you already 😊



We use these resources to help us add and subtract. We will also be counting in 2's, 5's and 10's – it would be great if you started to practise this before September 😊

LEARNING IN YEAR 1

In Year 2 we do lots of interesting topics. In the autumn term we learn about 'Toys' (how great does that sounds?!). We find out what toys are made from, what our favourite toys are and we will look back at the toys our parents/grandparents played with when they were younger.



UNIFORM

All P.E. kit and uniform MUST be labelled, including jumpers and cardigans.

We expect the children to take responsibility for their own uniform. It is much easier for them to find their own clothes after P.E. or if they take off their jumper or cardigan during the school day.

Please encourage your child to practise getting himself/herself changed ready for September.
