Reception	Simple greetings in other languages: hello, goodbye and answering the register. Pupils with EAL share their first language with others and cultural diversity in class and school is celebrated.

Year 2	Simple greetings in other languages: hello, goodbye and answering the register. Counting to 10 in French and another language. Pupils with EAL share their first language with others and cultural diversity in class and school is celebrated.		
Year 3	-Count in French from 0 – 10 -Ask for and state age in French, using knowledge of numbers to 10.	-Greetings in French, asking and saying how are you? -Ask for and give name in French.	-Naming colours in French and writing colours in French. -Begin to name and write days of the week.
Year 4	-Name the body parts in French.	-Naming family roles in French and asking and answering questions about family members.	-Naming zoo animals in French. -Using adjectives in conversations about zoo animals and writing sentences in French using nouns and adjectives.
Year 5	-Name buildings on the high street in French and start to give directions.	-Pronouncing months of the year in French and writing sentences about social conventions at home and in other cultures.	-Naming days of the week in French before giving the full date. -Accurately pronouncing different weather conditions typical of months of the year.
Year 6	-Respond to class instructions in French, including answering the register, saying the date and describing the weather.	-Recap days of the weeks and months from Y5 before writing a plan for going on holiday, investigating climate and selecting dates.	-Writing a letter in French to book accommodation for a holiday. -Use the internet to research foods typical of a country and make a note of French dishes to try.
Whole School Celebrations	-European Day of Languages Sunday 26 th September 2021. Assembly during that week to create awareness of this and celebrate learning different languages and about other cultures. - Christmas in France – how Christmas is celebrated. -Bastille Day on 14 th July 2022. Assembly to teach children why this is so important in France and how it is celebrated. Children to learn why the French Revolution was important not just for France but Europe and the world.		
Additional Information	We use "La Jolie Ronde" scheme of work to teach French in KS2. Pupils are taught to speak, read and write in French. Written work for each objective. Evidence can be recorded on iPads for spoken objectives.
